To whom it may concern,

I am writing this letter on behalf of Keith Dunn who presented at our school, West Windsor-Plainsboro High School South, on October 10, 2013. We brought Mr. Dunn in as a part of our Week of Respect Program. Mr. Dunn presented his "Submit" program to the entire freshman class, which covered topics specific to cyber bullying.

In his hour-long program, Keith Dunn, or KDCOP as he refers to himself, covered different topics of cyber bullying. He talked about the different types of cyber bullying which exist, some potential consequences that can come from this behavior, and some ways that students can stand up against such harmful conduct. Mr. Dunn used videos from a select few people's personal stories throughout his presentation. He integrated these videos and stories into his program's message. They are a very intense part of his program, and show how far bullying can potentially go.

At the end of his program, Mr. Dunn opened the floor up to students. He asked them to volunteer ways that they have seen and dealt with bullying. This is an open and fluid discussion which brought about some good ideas and suggestions on the part of the students.

Mr. Dunn stayed for break-out sessions which followed his program. Our break-outs were led by our senior Peer Leaders. The Peer Leaders led a discussion and addressed any topics that came up from the program. They also talked about appropriate, positive ways to use technology versus destructive and harmful ways. Mr. Dunn walked around to all groups and answered any questions that came up in the break-out groups, clarified any issues or concerns that anyone may have had, and facilitated discussions helping the students understand the ways that they can deal with bullying, both as individuals and as a whole student body.

In working with Mr. Dunn, I found that he was very willing to tailor the program to our school's specific concerns. He worked with my Principal and myself to see that the content was appropriate for our students, and to comply with our wishes.
